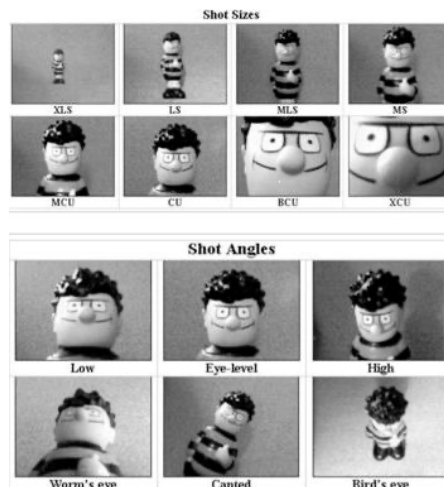

















Grade 10 Religion Through the Arts - Film Shot Sizes & Angles
