A DEEPER LOOK



Having now viewed Darren Aronofsky's *Noah*, answer the following questions in a dynamically designed power point presentation.

1. Find the inaccuracies! The first portion of your power point should focus on where the film maker took liberties in retelling the story of Noah. Examine characters and elements of the story. I am looking for FIVE points in this section. Might I suggest reading the **Noah** story as it appears in the OLD TESTAMENT. Noah appears in Genesis 5:29 as the son of Lamech and ninth in descent from Adam. And, in the **story** of the Flood (Genesis 6:11–9:19).
2. Cinematography! We discussed cinematography last week. There are videos for review at kevinolidano.com if you need a refresher! Take what you learned about camera work, symbolism/ imagery, music to discuss how Aronofsky was able to tell such a powerful story. I am looking for FIVE points in this section also. Be very specific here. Examine moments of the film that stood out to you. How was Aronofsky able to “grab you” and submerge you into the world of Noah?
3. CRITIQUE! What did you think? We spoke at length about the film. Did you like it? Yes or no? Provide THREE final slides backing up why you liked or disliked the film. Try not to be on the fence. Be firm with your position, but be sure to have reasons to back up your position.
