<b>EVENT/ CHARACTER</b>	<b>FACT or FICTION (circle one)</b>
<p><b>Film Depiction</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Thoroughly discuss how the character and event were depicted in the film</li> <li>- <b>Event:</b> Describe the event in detail. How did it come to pass? How important was the event to the overall telling of the story?</li> <li>- <b>Character:</b> Who portrayed the character? Along with character traits, discuss the actions and words of the character. How would you describe the character after viewing the film?</li> </ul>	
<p><b>HISTORICAL DETAILS/ EVIDENCE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Event:</b> Thoroughly discuss the historical truths behind the people and event depicted in the film</li> <li>- <b>Character:</b> Find out as much as you can about the true lives of the individuals being studied. State all you can about their personalities and about key happenings in their lives. You must determine whether or not the true actions and words of these people were accurately shown in the film.</li> </ul>
